



## BEFORE OR AFTER DINNER

### Single Malt Scotches

#### **Balvenie 12 year-old Doublewood (Speyside, Scotland) 16**

*Aged for 12 years in American Oak ex-bourbon barrels and hogsheads, then in Spanish sherry casks. Sweet fruit and sherry notes, layered with honey and vanilla on the nose. Smooth and mellow with beautifully combined flavors nutty sweetness, cinnamon spiciness and a delicately proportioned layer of sherry.*

#### **Lagavulin 16 year-old (Islay, Scotland) 20**

*This scotch is Intensely flavored, with peat smoke, iodine and seaweed and a rich, deep sweetness. On the nose. Dry peat smoke fills the palate with a gentle but strong sweetness, followed by sea and salt with touches of wood.*

### Whiskies

#### **Michel Couvreur Overaged Malt Whiskey (Burgundy, France) 18**

*Michel imports scotch between 12 and 27 years old then ages them in used Sherry casks (butts) before bottling. The result is a nut-brown hue and rich dried date and caramel scent. The big, rounded palate surprises with smoke, underpinned with hints of Sherry, dried fig, and caramel, with a long baking spice finish.*

#### **Hibiki Harmony (Japan) 20**

*A blend of malt and grain whiskies. On the nose, rose, lychee, a hint of rosemary, mature woodiness and sandalwood. On the palate, honey like sweetness, candied orange peel and white chocolate.*

#### **Redbreast 12 year-old Cask Strength (Ireland) 20**

*Triple pot distilled, malted and unmalted barley that is aged in Bourbon and Sherry casks. On the nose, succulent exotic fruit with a little citrus, complementing deeper notes of dried apricot and sultana. Infusion of assorted spices and toasted wood. On the palate, Rich, fully rounded and mellow with luscious fruit and spices. Sweetness of vanilla and a touch of oak.*

### Bourbons

#### **Rabbit Hole Heigold (Kentucky) 14**

*A high Rye Bourbon only available in six states. Rich, fully rounded and mellow with luscious fruit and spices. Sweetness of vanilla and a touch of oak. fresh and delicate rosé with faint floral aromas, fresh, focused and clean, with tasty flavors.*

#### **George T. Stagg 2019 (Kentucky) 25**

*A 15 year-old Bourbon from Buffalo Trace. Lush toffee sweetness and dark chocolate with hints of vanilla, fudge, nougat and molasses. Underlying notes of dates, tobacco, dark berries, spearmint and a hint of coffee round out the palate.*

### Cognac/Port

#### **Warres Quinta da Cavadinha 2001 (Porto, Portugal) 12**

*A single-quinta (vineyard) vintage port. Quinta da Cavadinha is one of the finest vineyard estates in the Douro and the name is given to one of Warres flagship wines, made when they do not declare the vintage – as in 2001. A rich, enticing nose full of jammy hedgerow fruits, licorice and cloves..*

#### **Marnier XO (France) 16**

*Lush toffee sweetness and dark chocolate with hints of vanilla, fudge, nougat and molasses. Underlying notes of dates, tobacco, dark berries, spearmint and a hint of coffee round out the palate.*
